118 Blessed By Beads (Age 9 & up) - A beading and wire wrapping class evangelizing God's given talents to us, then using them to help others. This class will teach basic jewelry making techniques, wiring wrapping, and using beads to enhance & decorate household items. The emphasis of the class will be gift giving of the handmade items. The class will hold two craft sales, one at Christmas and one in May, for the purpose of selling the handmade items, with proceeds being donated. **Lab fee \$15**

113 Christian Video and Film Production Level II (Ages 13 & up) As second year students, we will explore many more aspects of video production such as, Adobe After Effects and Adobe Encore. Students will also learn different aspects of the filmmaking process, such as scriptwriting and storyboarding. As a class, we will work together in creating a short film. You must complete Film and Video Production- Level 1 to attend this class.

133 Intro to Worship Dance (Age 4 - 5) - Pray, Praise & Preparation for worship as well as development of flexibility & strength, ballet basics on barre, center floor and worship dance movements. Christian & Classical artists and worship CD's will set the tone for class.

121b Second Year Sign Language - We will be continue to learn American Sign Language (ASL) in a format called PSE (Pigeon Signed English). These are just fancy terms for saying that the ASL will be signed in spoken English word order. As we review the alphabet and numbers we will be touching on various concepts of time, emotion, nature, food, sports, animals and education,. This class will cover a basic broad spectrum.
