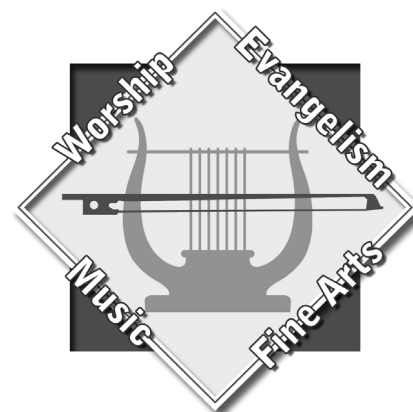


Certificates will be presented to all students who participate in classes throughout the school year. Certificates will be handed out at the end of the year Recital on Thursday evening, May 20, 2010.

- Daily practice is vital to success when learning to play an instrument. A minimum of thirty minutes each day is required for best results. Practice cards will be given to instrumental students to keep track of their daily practice. Parents are asked to sign the card and students are to bring the card to class each week.
- Instrumental students must provide their own instruments. Most instruments can be rented from local music stores. No previous musical instruction or skill is required for Beginning Level classes.

CLASS TIME SCHEDULE

1:00 p.m. - 1:45 p.m.

Beginners Sign Language (Age 6 - 9) - We will have fun in this course, being introduced to the world of sign language. We will be learning American Sign Language (ASL) in a format called PSE (Pigeon Signed English). These are just fancy terms for saying that the ASL will be signed in spoken English word order. From learning the alphabet to signing the animals at the zoo, this class will cover the basics. We will be praising God all the way too, by learning how to sign worship songs and simple prayers.

Choir - (Age 7 & older) Students will learn many vocal and breathing techniques, warm-up exercises, music theory and different rhythms along with singing a variety of music.

1:15 p.m. - 2:00 p.m.

Helping Hands in the Home (Ages 11 & up) - Students will grow in self initiative, going beyond chores, learning to be organized, enhancing the gift of hospitality and the practical skills of laundry, cooking, baking, home finances, etc. The students will learn to serve their families and others, motivated by love as they strive for excellence based on biblical principles of building a Christian home.

Second and Third Year Strings - A continuation of classes for all second and third year violin, viola and cello students.

1:45 p.m. - 2:30 p.m.

Beginners Sign Language (Age 10 & up) - We will have fun in this course being introduced to the world of sign language. We will be learning American Sign Language (ASL) in a format called PSE (Pigeon Signed English). These are just fancy terms for saying that the ASL will be signed in spoken English word order. From learning the alphabet and numbers to touching on various concepts of time, emotion, nature, food, sports, animals and education, this class will cover a basic broad spectrum. We will also be praising God by signing worship songs.

2:00 p.m. - 3:00 p.m.

String Orchestra - For all violin, viola, cello and string bass students who have played their instrument for two years or more. Music theory, scales and etudes will be incorporated into all lessons. A variety of music, including quartets, chamber music and worship music will be performed.

CLASS TIME SCHEDULE

12:00 p.m. - 12:45 p.m.

Beginning Percussion (Age 11 & older) - A rubber practice pad and size 5A or 2B drum sticks are needed for class. The lesson book and CD will be ordered through Psalmist when you enroll for the class.

Ballroom Dance (Age 13 & up) - This class will provide character building skills, such as discipline, leading and following, patience, listening, and communication. Ballroom is extremely successful in developing manners, motor skills, grace and poise, balance and co-ordination with the music. Registering with a partner is "highly" recommended but, not required.

Photography 101 (Ages 13 & up) - Offers the student the opportunity to learn more about the mechanics of digital photography focusing mainly on the "art of photography" with emphasis on the subject, balance and color content of the photos. Class requirements include a digital camera and access/knowledge of a computer and printer for weekly assignments.

12:15 p.m. - 1:00 p.m.

Beginning Piano (Age 7 - 9) - Students will learn hand position, finger numbers, basic rhythms, musical terms and be introduced to all key names as well as pre-reading pieces. Piano students must have a piano or keyboard at home for daily practice. Psalmist will provide keyboards for classroom use.

Parents are encouraged to attend the first class with their child.

12:30 p.m. - 1:15 p.m.

Beginning Strings (Age 9 & up) Learn to play the Violin, Viola, or Cello. No previous musical experience necessary.

12:45 p.m. - 1:30 p.m.

Advanced Visual Arts (Age 14 & up) - Two years of previous art instruction is required for this class. Instruction for the middle school age student will include drawing skills, multi-media projects, cartooning and the study of famous artists. A few art sessions will be on "You Be The Critic", where the student will learn to critique famous art work.

Teen Ballroom Dance II (Age 13 & up) - This class is a continuation of beginner level, please sign in pairs (boy/girl) to help insure even numbers for the class. Students should have completed Level one or understand basics in Waltz, Swing & Salsa to enter this class. Goal for this class is to work toward mastering dances, understanding the importance of Center and the biblical applications. Christian, Classical, "Fish" friendly music will be used to develop routines for ministry at Senior Centers (For those who wish to participate)

Second Year Percussion - Continuing from first year classes.

11:00 a.m. - 11:45 p.m.

Second Year Young Violinists - Continuing from where the first year of lessons left off, students will develop their note reading skills and rhythm recognition as they develop their violin playing technique. The Suzuki Method will be incorporated into their training.

Healthy Living "Thoroughly Fit" (for all High School students and Moms) - This class will help you make a lifestyle change in your Physical, Spiritual, Emotional and Mental self. Getting healthy is something we all need to work on. Our textbook will be "Thoroughly Fit", by Becky Tirabassi.

3-D Studio Art/Workshop - (Ages 12 & up) - Designed for the young artist looking for some experience in 3-dimensional art. The student may work on one project for several weeks. Areas of study include sculpture, free form, fiber design, printing and much more. A wonderful opportunity to explore another aspect of art.

Un-text Messaging: A creative writing class with oral interpretation (Age 13 & up) - Writing involves more than the use of two thumbs and this class will teach you how! Narrative, informative, persuasive and descriptive writing techniques will be taught. Relearning the basics of letter writing and sending thank you cards will be discussed. Emphasis will be placed on writing coherent sentences with proper punctuation and grammar. At home essays will be assigned weekly.

Ballroom Dance (Age 6 - 12) - Basic steps of ballroom & Latin dancing. The importance of Lead & Follow and how they relate to God's order and purpose. Christian, Classical and "Fish" friendly music will be used to develop routines for ministry at Senior Centers. (For those who wish to participate)

Worship Dance II (Age 8 & up) - Short Bible study on worship, as well as basic ballet technique and worship movement. A variety of Christian music artists and worship music CD's will be the backdrop for the dance class.

11:15 a.m. - 12:30 p.m.

Advanced Drama - (Age 13 & older) - This class is for students who have taken at least two years of drama or have special permission from the teacher. The students will study characterization and prepare to use drama as a form of evangelism. There will be an end of the year drama presentation.

12:00 p.m. - 12:45 p.m.

Advanced Visual Arts (Age 11 - 14) - Two years of previous art instruction is required for this class. Instruction for the middle school age student will include drawing skills, multi-media projects, cartooning and the study of famous artists. A few art sessions will be on "You Be The Critic", where the student will learn to critique famous art work.

10:15 a.m. - 11:00 a.m.

Third Year Young Violinists - Continuing from the second year lessons, students will develop their reading skills, rhythms and music theory while strengthening their playing technique. The Suzuki Method curriculum and worship songs will be used in class

Worship Dance I (Age 6 - 8) - Short Bible study on worship, as well as basic ballet technique, and worship movement. A variety of Christian music artists and worship music CD's will be the backdrop for the dance class.

Learning about God "A to Z" (Ages 6 - 8) - The 26 letters of the alphabet will be used to describe God, beginning with God is Almighty! Each class will expand on the alphabet word, crafts will be included to further instill that week's lesson. Children should have a grasp of reading, knowledge of the alphabet and should bring a Bible to class. Hand-outs will be given weekly, to challenge the children to continue reading Scripture at home!

Mommy and Me Dance and Movement Class (Mom & child, 2-5 years old) - This class will offer an introduction to basic elements of ballet. Class will begin with a warm-up, continue with a short time at the bar and center work. An anchor fun dance will finish each class. We will develop listening and execution skills, motor skills and social skills. It is also a nice gentle work out for busy moms. Moms with two little ones will also be accepted.

10:30 a.m. - 11:15 p.m.

Beginning Drama - (Ages 10 & up) - Students will learn the fundamentals of drama and basic skills of performance. This class will encourage the students to develop characterization and explore ways of using drama as a form of evangelism.

11:00 a.m. - 11:45 p.m.

Helping Hands in the Home (Ages 5 - 10) - Students will grow in self initiative, going beyond chores, being motivated by love, learning to be organized, enhancing the gift of hospitality and the practical skills of laundry, cooking, baking, home finances, etc. The students will learn to serve their families and others as they strive for excellence based on biblical principles of building a Christian home.

CLASS TIME SCHEDULE

8:45 a.m. - 9:30 a.m.

Beginning Piano - (Age 9 & up) - Students will learn hand position, finger numbers, basic rhythms, musical terms and be introduced to all key names as well as pre-reading pieces. Piano students must have a piano or keyboard at home for daily practice. Psalmist will provide keyboards for classroom use.

Parents are encouraged to attend the first class with their child.

Visual Arts (Ages 5 - 7) - Back to basics with emphasis on the elements of Art. Line, shape, color, value, texture, form and space. We will work in a variety of mediums and explore famous artists. Some assignments in this class may take on a more "craft-type approach" with projects and learning experiences more suited for younger children and smaller hands.

Worship Team - (Age 13 & up) - Open to vocalists and students who play acoustic guitar, electric guitar, bass guitar, drums, and keyboard. This class will challenge students in the following areas: Playing and singing together as a team, worship leading, song selection, music administration, basic sound and lyric projection, team dynamics, performance mentality vs. the heart of worship, as well as what the Bible says about worship.

9:15 a.m. - 10:15 a.m.

Advanced Worship Dance (Age 12 & up) - This class is for the older student who has completed Worship Dance I and II or by special permission from the teacher.

9:30 a.m. - 10:15 a.m.

Blessed By Beads (Age 9 & up) - A beading and wire wrapping class evangelizing God's given talents to us, then using them to help others. This class will teach basic jewelry making techniques, wiring wrapping, and using beads to enhance & decorate household items. The emphasis of the class will be gift giving of the handmade items. The class will hold two craft sales, one at Christmas and one in May, for the purpose of selling the handmade items, with proceeds being donated.

Christian Video and Film Production (Ages 13 & up) Students will have hands-on experience in learning how to turn their ideas into a movie. We will touch on different aspects of filmmaking such as scriptwriting, storyboarding, camera operation, lighting, directing and editing. Through this course, students will work together to apply what they've learned to make a short movie that honors Christ.

CLASS TIME SCHEDULE

9:30 a.m. - 10:15 a.m.

Music for Little Mozarts (Ages 4 - 7) Students will be introduced to appropriate piano instruction for their age level, such as finger numbers and moving up and down the keyboard, high and low sounds, quarter notes and rests and bar lines. Singing, rhythm and listening skills are developed along with an appreciation for a variety of musical styles. Piano or keyboard is highly recommended for home, but not necessary. Parents are encouraged to attend the first class with their child.

Second Year Guitar - (acoustic or bass) - Open to all students who have completed the beginning guitar class. The emphasis will be to begin transitioning from the technical skill needed to play guitar to how the guitar can be used effectively for worship. Students will continue to learn new worship songs while also learning advanced chords, song writing, scales and chord theory. No electric guitars.

Visual Arts (Ages 8 - 11) - "Every child is an artist. The problem is how to remain an artist once he grows up." by Picasso. Calling all artists to join in an art class where we will explore various mediums and famous artists. We will, through art, give our Lord the glory for the talent He's given us.
